

Client Portal Terms & Conditions

By registering for and using the **Code Quore Technologies Client Portal ("Portal")**, you ("**Client**", "**User**", or "**Authorized Representative**") agree to comply with and be bound by the following *Terms & Conditions*. All information provided during registration must be accurate, complete, and up to date.

1. Account Registration and Accuracy of Information.

- a. You represent and warrant that all information provided during registration is accurate, complete, current, and legally valid.
- b. You agree to promptly update any information that becomes inaccurate, outdated, or incomplete.
- c. **Code Quore Technologies** reserves the right to verify the authenticity of information provided and may suspend access pending verification.
